

Specific Recital Guidelines 2016-2017

“Masquerade, Paper Faces on Parade” – Saturday, October 15, 2016 – 1:00 pm – Apollo Theatre

- Students must dress up in costume presenting a visual effect pertaining to their performance piece.
- Duets and ensembles are encouraged.
- Memorization is not required.
- In lieu of a costume, students may display a visual “prop” to communicate their selection
- All general recital guidelines apply.

“Welcome to the Movies” – Saturday, October 15 2016 - 3:00 pm – Apollo Theatre

- All music selections must be associated with a Motion Picture, Broadway show, TV show, etc.
- Duets and ensembles are encouraged.
- Memorization is not required.
- All general recital guidelines apply

“Deck the Halls” – Saturday, December 3, 2016 – 10:00am – 8:00 pm – Bass Pro Shops

- Holiday / Christmas Music / Festive / Seasonal
- Students perform as background music for the shoppers.
- Duets and ensembles are encouraged.
- No audience seating is provided. Limited “spectator” space.
- 5 student limit is waived; common sense prevails.
- Memorization is not required.

“Let’s Get Together” - Saturday, February 18, 2017, 2:00pm – Piano Network

- All music selections must involve more than one player/instrumentalist. This could be duets, trios, an instrument accompanied by the piano, etc. Be creative!
- Memorization is not required
- All general recital guidelines apply

Honors Recital – Saturday, April 22, 2017 -- 2:00 pm – First Christian Church

- It is an ‘honor’ to be chosen to play in this recital. This recital is to acknowledge those students who went “above and beyond” during the year, exhibiting above average performances. Students who excel in AIM are often recommended to be in this recital, but a student does not need to participate in AIM in order to perform in this recital.
- Memorization IS required.
