Also please let your students' parents know that for the concert, <u>ticket prices</u> will be \$5 for individuals age 13 and over, and \$3 for students 12 and under. Please remember that this first rehearsal in October is MANDATORY. Also for those students rehearsing at ICC on Sundays, only the students participating should be in the building. Any parents or siblings need to stay outside in their cars because there will be classes going on at that time, and we need to have the hallways quiet. I hope everyone has been having fun teaching the pieces, and the students also have been having fun learning them. See you at the first rehearsal!

**Pam Eyerly,** who performs with the *Prairie Wind Ensemble,* invites you to their first concert of the 2011-12 season on Sunday, October 9<sup>th</sup> at 2:30 p.m at the ICC Performing Arts Center. Dr. Joseph Manfredo of Illinois State University will be conducting. The program includes *Symphonic Dance #3: Fiesta,* by Clifton Williams; *Fantasy Variations on a Theme by Niccolo Paganini* by James Barnes; *March and Procession of Bacchus* by Leo Delibes/arr. by Eric Osterling, and *Musical Highlights from the MGM Film "That's Entertainment",* arr. By Elliot Gilman. Guest Bassoon soloist, Elizabeth Smiley, wll perform the first movement of Mozart's bassoon concerto. Come go "Over the River and Through the Woods" with **Liz Reed** and her cast and crew at Peoria Players Theatre. Although it is not a musical, there are some tidbits of music in it. You will be able to hear Mike Dentino sing "Yes Sir That's My Baby" and you will also hear a little mandolin strumming upon occasion. The play is a touching family comedy (rated PG-13) and opens Friday, October 7<sup>th</sup> at 7:30 p.m. It runs at the same time on the 8<sup>th</sup>, 13<sup>th</sup>, 14<sup>th</sup>, and 15<sup>th</sup>, and there are also two Sunday matinees – October 9<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> at 2:00 p.m. The Peoria Players Box Office number is 688-4473. All tickets are \$10 with open seating at the theatre at Five Points. This concert is geared for families, kids, grandparents – everyone! It's a dramatic and musical portrait of the mysterious and difficult Mr B. It will include the actors of Classical Kids Live!.
